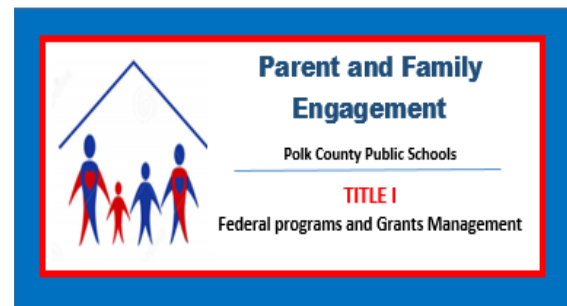

**Built in 2005**, Lake Alfred-Addair Middle School has 29 classroom teachers, 10 resource teachers, 9 paraprofessionals and 20 other staff. The enrollment data collected in spring 2016 was 760 students. Of this total enrollment, 31% African-American, 29% Caucasian, and 36% Hispanic.
